NOTICE TO TRADERS (CASUAL)

- 1. A license to trade in these Markets is granted at Council's pleasure and Council has no obligation, express or implied, to grant a license to trade to anyone. Traders do not "own" sites they are licensed to use particular sites at Council's discretion.
- 2. The allocation of stall sites is solely at the Management's discretion. The use or subletting of sites by private agreement is not permitted.
- 3. Fees are payable on the market day. Once a trader has accepted a site allocation, fees must be paid irrespective of whether the trader wishes to trade for the whole day or only partthereof.
- 4. Table (and/or trestle) hire fees are payable at the markets cashier. Tables (and/or trestles) will only be issued to traders who produce a receipt confirming that the correct fee has been paid. All traders must return their tables (and/or trestles) to the table room at the close of business each market day. Failure to do so may result in the offending trader being refused tables (and/or trestles) in future.
- 5. Traders should ensure that they are issued with a receipt for all fees paid to the cashier.
- 6. It is the responsibility of every trader to pay at the Cashiers office before 10.00am, payments after that time may be subject to a \$5 surcharge per site.
- 7. Markets trading hours are from 9.00 am until 4.00 pm each market day. Unauthorised vehicle movement within the Market's confine is prohibited during these hours. Casual traders are required to have their stall(s) set up and their vehicles clear of the markets area by 9.00 a.m.
- 8. Traders and their staff should only park their vehicles in the designated traders car parks.
- 9. Casual traders are required to complete a Casual Trader Application form. Casual traders who have not registered will not be allocated a site.
- 10. Products not identified on the Casual Trader Application form may not be allowed to be sold on the day.
- 11. While the Markets offers no exclusivity for any particular product, care is taken to keep product away from like product. This is done at management's discretion.
- 12. Every trader is required to keep his/her effects within the defined area allocated to him/her. Non-compliance could result in the offender being refused access to the markets.
- 13. Each trader is responsible for observing the laws and by-laws in effect at the time regarding the merchandise he/she offers for sale or the amusements offered.
- 14. Traders are, at all times, to observe the instructions given to them by the Management and comply promptly with these instructions.
- 15. The keeping for sale, offering for sale or selling of counterfeit products is prohibited at Fairfield Market. Market Management has the right to immediately expel from the market any stallholder (meaning in the case of a natural person, that person and in the case of a company, the company and the person or persons conducting the business of that company at Fairfield Market) which Market Management has a reasonable basis to believe is trading in counterfeitproducts.
- 16. All food and beverage products are restricted.
- 17. In consideration of being granted entry to the Showground each such person expressly acknowledges and agrees that (subject only to gross negligence on the part of Showground staff or management, being the direct cause of any loss, damage or injury to occur), each person will enter upon the Showground premises and surrounds and/or will participate in the programs, utilise the equipment and/or take advantage of the services offered therein, absolutely at his or her own risk, such that each person RELEASES AND DISCHARGES Fairfield Showground, its management, staff and contractors from all liability for loss, damage or injury which may be sustained by each such person in such manner or under such circumstances, as previously set out in this clause.
- 18. Each Trader expressly acknowledges and agrees that despite his/her license to trade, he/she is nonetheless subject to and must fully comply with the Terms and Conditions of Entry to the Fairfield Showground, in force from time to time.
 - Terms & Conditions of Entry to Fairfield Showground are located at all main entrances. In the event of an inconsistency between the Notice to Traders and the Terms & Conditions of Entry to Fairfield Showground, the Terms & Conditions of Entry to the Fairfield Showground will take precedence over the Notice to Traders (Casual), which will then be deemed to have been amended accordingly, to allow for any such inconsistency.
